

## Frequently asked Questions:

### What is the European Hair Research Society (EHRS)?

The EHRS is an independent, non-profit organization dedicated to promoting the research of hair biology and hair diseases in Europe. The EHRS has an international membership of scientists, dermatologists, and professionals working in academia, industry, and government.

The EHRS represents its members by promoting the pursuit of clinical and scientific excellence and the dissemination of information in hair research and encourages the scientific careers of junior investigators.

The EHRS serves as an advocate and resource for increasing public and government awareness of the needs for, and advances resulting from, hair research.

The EHRS supports and organizes regular meetings dedicated to the presentation of new research and clinical findings, exchange of information, education of its members, and the advancement of science.

### Who are the Members?

Scientists, dermatologists, and other professionals working in academia (universities or other teaching facilities), industry (research active companies), and government.

What are the membership benefits?

Access to exchange of research findings and education through annual meetings and website postings.

### Can a company or clinic become a member?

No. The EHRS do not offer corporate membership. Only individual members can join the EHRS and must state in their literature that the membership is for them personally.

### As a Member can I use the name and logo of the EHRS?

The EHRS is a society not a qualification. You can state that you are a member of the EHRS in your literature as long as you are a member in good standing and have paid the current year's subscription. You can state that you attended and/or made a presentation of research findings at a meeting.

You **cannot** make any claims of endorsement by the EHRS for any services that you provide **nor** can you claim any professional advantage by being a member, **nor** can you display the logo in any literature associated with any product or service.

The EHRS logo may, on occasion, be used by members with explicit written permission by the Board; permission only being granted for a specific instance, time and place. (i.e. not in perpetuity).
