The EHRS Board awards travel grants to support early career scientists and clinicians to attend our conferences.

EHRS TRAVEL GRANTS 2018

The European Hair Research Society (EHRS) is offering 10 travel grants worth 500 Euros each for the 18th meeting of the EHRS, May 18-20th, Bologna, Italy. Grants are awarded to encourage attendance by younger investigators, who are submitting an abstract for oral or poster presentation at the meeting. The grant is designed to help cover the applicants' travel, hotel and/or other expenses. The EHRS will also provide complimentary conference registration to travel grant winners. Of the 10 grants available, 6 will go to investigators in Europe, while there is 1 available for each of our sister societies.

Information for Applicants

- Young investigators working in Europe are strongly encouraged to apply. Preference will go to those in early career scientific and clinical positions including undergraduates, PhD students, residents, 1st/2nd year postdoctoral scientists or individuals who demonstrate financial need.
- If the applicant is not currently a member of the EHRS, membership fees will be deducted from the awarded amount.
- Awards will be conditional on the abstract being accepted by the meeting organizers.
- The deadline to apply for an EHRS Travel Grant is 5pm UK time on March 30th 2018. Please do not leave until the last minute to prepare and submit your application. **NB Travel grant and abstract deadline are the same day.**

The awards will be decided by the EHRS board and notification will be confirmed by email by April 13th 2018.

The EHRS Secretary will announce the successful grant recipients during the General Assembly on Saturday May 19th 2018. Awardees are requested to attend the General Assembly and the Closing Ceremony to receive their certificates.

1. Name, address and contact details (e-mail body).
2. A copy of the submitted abstract indicating if it is submitted for an oral/poster presentation.
3. Short Curriculum Vitae (2pg).
4. A short letter (200 words) explaining why this candidate is eligible and entitled for this grant.
5. A supporting letter from the candidate's supervisor.
