Travel Grants The EHRS Board awards travel grants to support early career scientists and clinicians to attend our conferences.

EHRS TRAVEL GRANTS 2019

The European Hair Research Society (EHRS) is offering travel grants worth 500 Euros each for the 11th World Congress for Hair Research (WCHR), April 23rd-27th, Sitges, Spain. Grants are awarded to encourage attendance by younger investigators, who have submitted an abstract for oral or poster presentation at the meeting. The grant is designed to help cover the applicants' travel, hotel and/or other expenses. The EHRS will also provide complimentary conference registration to travel grant winners.

Information for Applicants

- Young investigators working in Europe are strongly encouraged to apply. Preference will go to those in early career scientific and clinical positions including undergraduates, PhD students, residents, 1st/2nd year postdoctoral scientists or individuals who demonstrate financial need.
- If the applicant is not currently a member of the EHRS, membership fees will be deducted from the awarded amount.
- Awards will be conditional on the applicant having submitted an abstract for presentation at the meeting.
- The deadline to apply for an EHRS Travel Grant is 5pm UK time on March 15th 2019. The awards will be decided by the EHRS board and notification will be confirmed by email by March 30th 2019.

The EHRS Secretary will announce the successful grant recipients during the General Assembly at the WCHR. Awardees are requested to attend the General Assembly and the Closing Ceremony to receive their certificates.

Applications process

Please submit the following as a **single PDF document** to secretary@ehrs.org with 'EHRS2019 Travel Grant' written in the subject line.

1. Name, address and contact details (e-mail body).
2. A copy of the submitted abstract indicating if it was accepted for an oral or poster presentation.
3. Short Curriculum Vitae (2pg).
4. A short letter (200 words) explaining why this candidate is eligible and entitled for this grant.
5. A supporting letter from the candidate's supervisor.
